AGED CARE EMERGENCY SERVICE (ACE)

A partnership between Hunter Primary Care, Hunter New England Local Health District, Hunter New England Central Coast Primary Health Network, NSW Ambulance, Residential Aged Care Facilities and GPs. The ACE service provides consultancy, clinical support, and advice for Residential Aged Care Facility staff and GPs to ensure care for residents can be delivered in the facility where appropriate.

PRIORITY ALLIED HEALTH SERVICES (PAHS)

Improving health and wellbeing for people living in rural locations.

Our Priority Allied Health Service delivers primary and allied health services in rural locations in the Hunter region. If you are a pensioner, Health Care Card holder or low-income earner who would not otherwise be able to access a local service you may be eligible for this service.

We aim to improve health and wellbeing by increasing access to the following services and locations:

Diabetes education: Aberdeen, Denman, Merriwa, Murrurundi, Muswellbrook, Scone

Dietetics: Muswellbrook, Scone, Singleton, Bulahdelah, Dungog, Forster, Gloucester, Taree, Wingham

Podiatry: Scone, Muswellbrook

Speech pathology: Gloucester, Forster, Taree

We also work to improve connections between allied health and general practice, provide integrated primary care and support preventative health programs.
